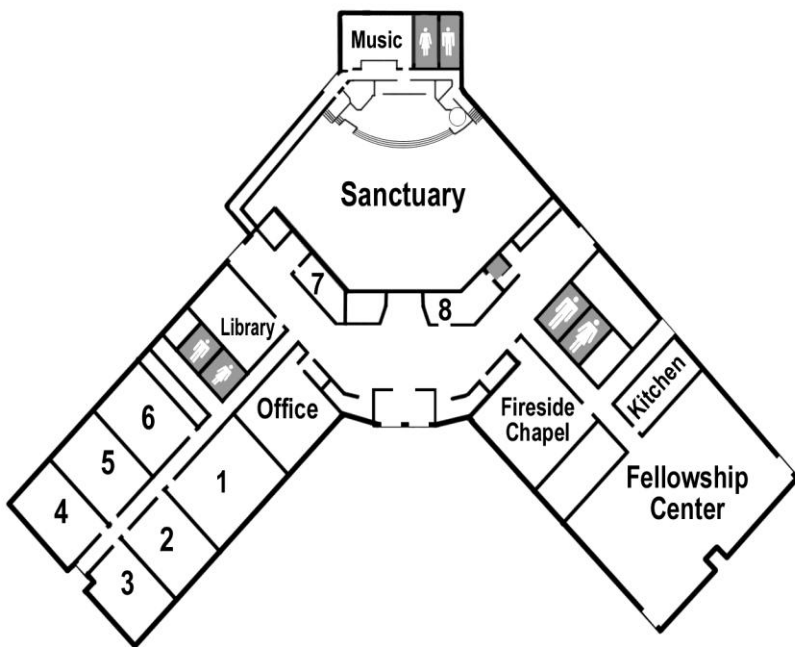

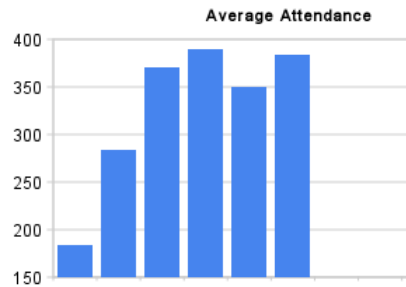

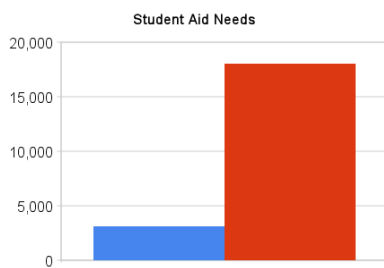


Attendance

Church attendance can be a sometimes fickle thing. It can go up, down and all around. Someone has once said you can tell how popular a church is by its attendance. You can tell how popular the preacher is by the number of speaking

appointments and you can tell how popular Jesus is by the number of people at prayer meeting.

It is with this in mind, that the attendance numbers for the last 6 years are presented. This shows that we have grown from an average attendance in 2004 of 184 to an average attendance in 2009 of 383 so far. Pray for us as we grow larger, that we'll also grow deeper. Wouldn't it be great, if our attendance would catch up to our membership of 702? Only 54% of our members are currently attending. Some are shut-ins, some have moved away. Do you know anyone that's no longer attending? Why not invite them back.



Student Aid Needs
