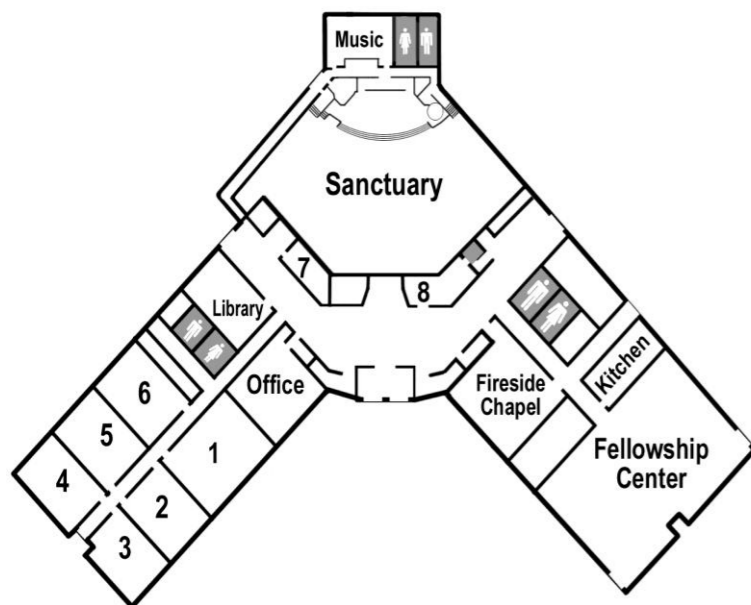

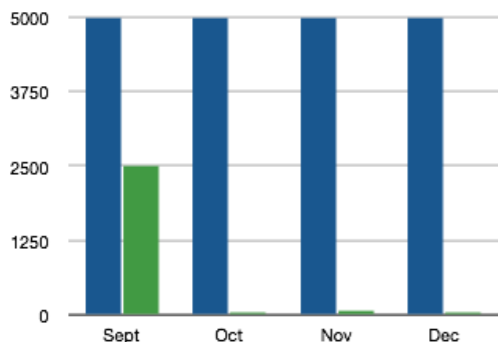

Giving is Behind

Our faith fund, the Student Aid Fund, is always a bit of a stretch. We have consistently supported more students with student aid than any of the other churches combined. This year, with many good reasons, we stretched ourselves even further and made a commitment that was larger than any made in recent years. Our commitment to the students and their parents is for \$50,000 for the school year. That means we need about \$5,000 per month. It also means that our giving is not up to par with our need.



You can see from the chart above that if that number continues, we will soon be supporting fewer kids - not because the needs are diminished, but because we simply cannot sustain our current support.

As a church, we believe in Christian schools and we believe in helping kids attend who normally may not be able to afford the tuition.
