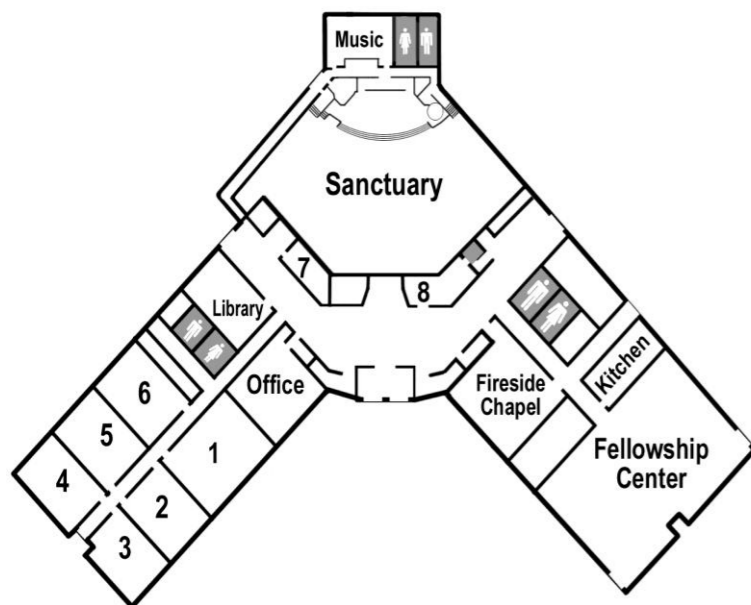

### Church Business Meeting

Last Sunday, we had our church business meeting where we voted to approve the Nominating Committee Report, approved the budget and talked about the mission of the church and where we were going next.

There was a good spirit and a sizable crowd who showed up. First we ate an awesome meal of soup, salad and dessert! Then at 6:00 pm, we continued with a slide show of the church and what has happened in the last year. It was obvious that our church photographers have spent good use of their time taking pictures and getting good shots of all that is happening.

Next, Pastor Roger led us in a discussion of the Mission and Core Values of the church. Later we broke up into groups and discussed what each group thought would be worthy goals to accomplish in the next three years.

Towards the end of the night, we discussed the church budget. We are running nearly \$10,000 behind in our church budget and almost \$3,000 behind in student aid. Lastly, we voted on the Nominating Committee Report, where we approved the next slate of church officers for the November 2009 - June 2011 term of service."
