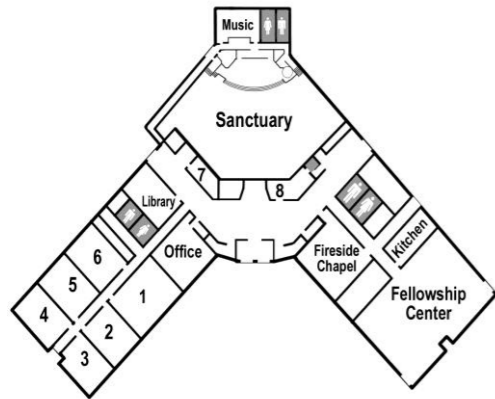

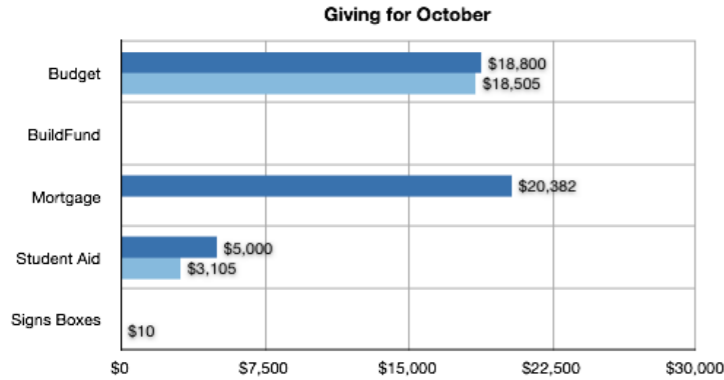

As many of you know, we have been running a little short recently in regards to things that run outside of the normal budget. Here is a chart that helps explain how we are doing. The top bar is the amount needed; the lower bar is what we have received.



Although the Budget looks relatively okay for this month (albeit a tad short) we are actually close to \$10,000 short for the year. We are nearly \$6,000 short for the year for Student Aid as well. As of this writing, we do not have numbers for the mortgage payment.
