Mission Update

Therefore, our singular mandate is to D.E.W. *Discipleship, Evangelism and Worship.*

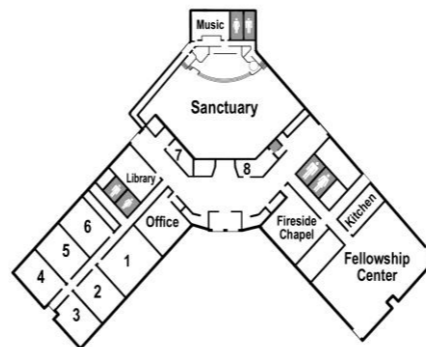
