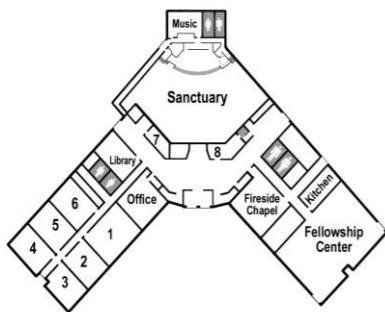

What's going on in the world? The financial world is still on the brink of disaster or greatness. The political situation around the world remains in turmoil. People we love are disappearing from our lives.

What's going on?

It all comes to show us that we have a mission in front of us. It's a mission to spread a message of hope and of God's grace. It's a message that is proclaimed in Revelation 14 by three angels. It's a message of truth and mercy. It's a message we need to be proclaiming.

This coming spring, we're hosting an event that will seek to promote that message. It's a spring evangelistic seminar that will seek to introduce people to the Jesus who loves them, saves them, and is coming again soon. We will preach a tremendous message that is urgent. Our society is falling apart, and people only have a limited time to help.

We have a budget to advertise to everyone in the county. We hope to bring out 150-200 guests on opening night. But our budget isn't supported by actual dollars yet. Would you consider giving to the Evangelism Fund? Would you consider giving a portion of your income beyond what you are currently giving to bring a saving message to your community?

We are looking to raise \$25,000 between now and March 1, 2010.

That's about \$8,400 a month between now and then. It's about \$110 per day that we need to raise, but it's only \$69 per active attendee in our church; that's only \$0.89 per day. It's cheaper than Starbucks by a long shot. It's cheaper than a can of pop. \$0.89/day can raise the needed funds for our upcoming evangelism. Would you be willing to give \$0.89/day to see someone come to the kingdom? For most families, that's about \$4-5/day. You can't even eat at Taco Bell for that much money. Would you be willing to give to see the kingdom grow?

Our Goal, is to see the Kingdom grow with people who want to grow their spiritual roots deeply. Thanks for your support.
