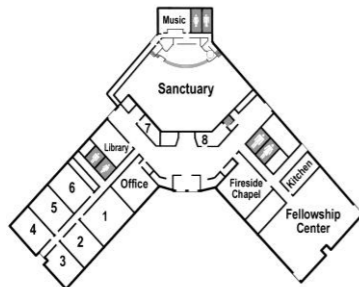

Many of you are acquainted with Martha McCormick, a 30-year member of the Vancouver church. You may or may not be aware of how active she's been in the Lord's service. Here are some highlights.

Martha and her husband Bob, who passed away in April of 1993, were heavily involved with Pathfinders before moving to Vancouver; they served in a variety of positions over time. Though not a leader here in Vancouver, Martha did teach the kite honor.

Martha became interested in kites and kite-making around 1980, and continues to build them yet. Her home is filled with kites of many sizes, shapes, colors and materials. She has sold kites and given others away as gifts. A few of you may be happy recipients of her work.

Martha also has a large doll collection; she repairs them when necessary and, in some cases, clothes them. Martha is a master seamstress. She has given many dolls as gifts over the years.

Related to Martha's sewing skills is a significant quilt-making history. She estimates she's sewn around 50 large ones over time, most of them given as gifts, and many, many baby-sized ones; these also were given as presents. Many of your little ones have been covered with one of Martha's quilts.

Martha has long been one of the faces of Clark County Adventist Community Services. She's one of the first people to be seen upon entering the building and has been for 21 years. She has, until the end of last month, worked at the front desk, greeting folks with a sweet smile and helping them with their clothing needs. She will be missed by clients and her fellow volunteers alike.

Martha epitomizes good will, generosity, and selflessness. It will be to Martha and others like her that the Lord will eventually say, "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!" (Matt. 25:21, NIV)

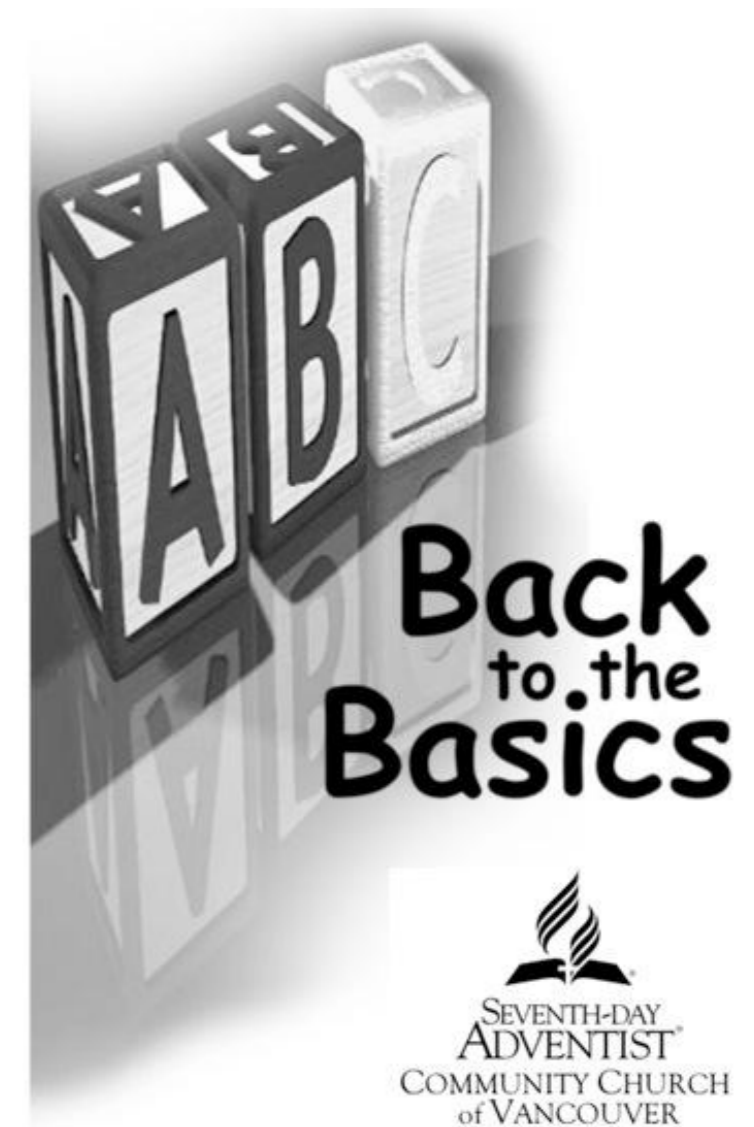
