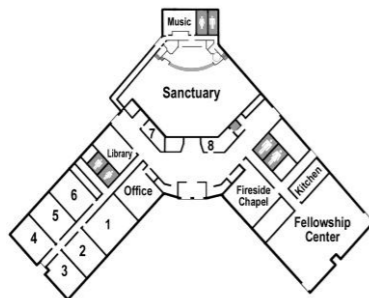

At Vancouver, we've always made a pretty serious commitment to Adventist Education. Combined with the subsidy and student aid, we commit a large amount in support of our schools and the kids who attend. We've currently made a commitment to nearly \$5000/month to student aid. All of the students we are supporting are excelling and deserve our continual support.

The Education Committee and Board took a step in faith that these kids needed to be at our local schools - MGES and CAA. They also took a step of faith to say we would support the students.

Our financial aid fund for the students currently enrolled is about to run out. We need close to \$5,000 each month, but the fund is down to \$800 this month. 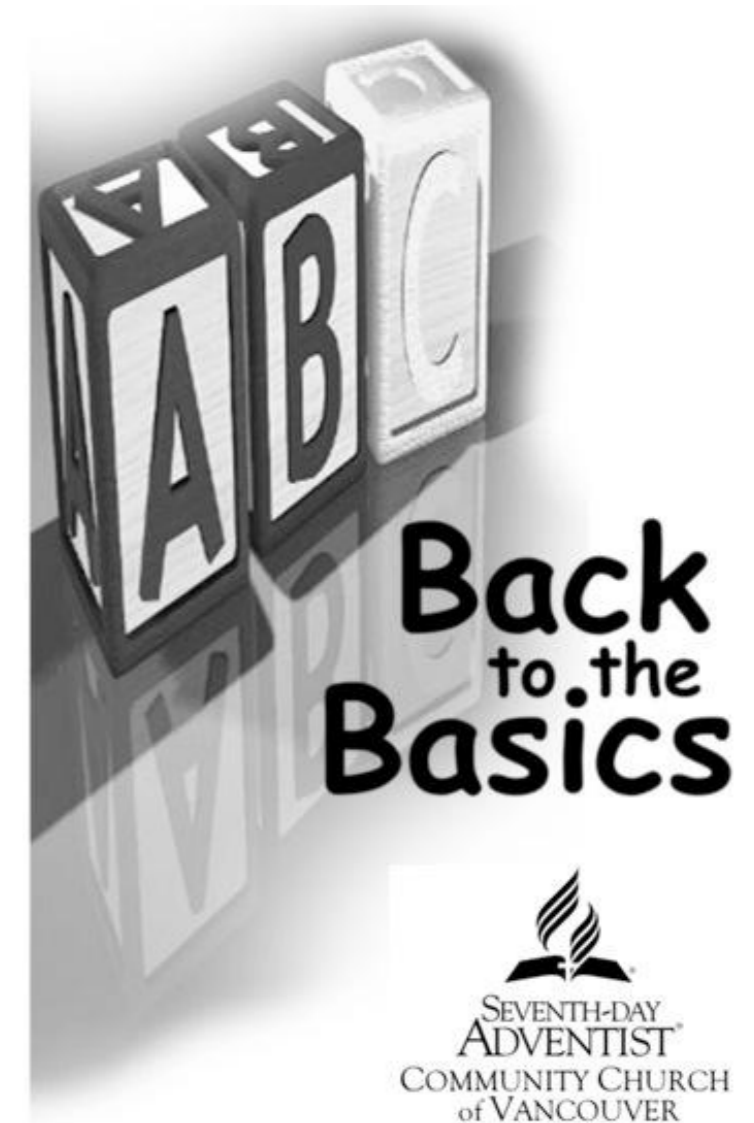
