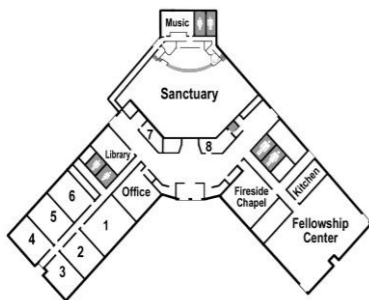

### D.E.W.

When the Garden of Eden was created, and all the way up to Noah's ark, it never rained. Never. The earth was watered and refreshed by the dew of heaven. We have many stories of dew in scripture.

Nebuchadnezzar drank the dew to survive his 7 years of living off the land. Gideon used the dew as a sign of God's pleasure. There are many more. But overall, dew is considered something refreshing, signaling new life, growth and nutrients.

The Mission/Vision Team has identified three things that are key to our survival and growth as a church. They are represented with the word D.E.W. - which stands for Discipleship, Evangelism and Worship. These three things are likely the three most important things the church does.

They are the three things that the church must succeed at to really be "the church." These are the things that we must corporately excel at.

So, we've set up some key features to measure so that we're actually accomplishing these three things. For discipleship, we'd like to see 35 new groups start in the next three years. For evangelism, we want to see over 300 people involved in some part of our evangelistic plan and become a partner with the church - helping us grow the kingdom. For worship, we believe that what happens on Sabbath morning is really a reflection of what happens in our personal devotional time during the week. So, we'd like to see 300 plus people having regular, personal devotional time.

We think this will be like the D.E.W. of Heaven to our church. It will allow us to find the spiritual nourishment and care every believer needs. It will also allow us to reach new people and to begin to bring worship front and center for everything that happens. D.E.W. - Discipleship, Evangelism and Worship - the three things that are critical for the church to prevail.
