Community News

The church's value shouldn't be measured by the number of people on the record books. It also shouldn't be measured by the number of dollars it spends on its programs, or the number of dollars it is able to collect in tithes and offerings. However, the church should be measured against some standard. What should that standard be?

It's pretty hard to measure a preacher's sermons - some think a particular one was awesome, others think so-so. Some say they are growing, but how do you measure if it's happening for everyone? Can you measure whether people like something or not? What do you measure in church?

The usual things we measure are tithe, attendance, membership and baptisms. They are measurements, but are they the best measurements?

With that in mind, we're looking at measuring the number of people who are in our Community Groups - it's our chief way of knowing whether discipleship is truly happening. We're also looking at measuring the number of people who are actively engaged in our evangelism process - because evangelism is dependent upon the Christian who will help to share the message. Finally, we're going to measure the number of people involved in a personal devotional life because this shows personal spiritual growth as well as our ability to worship together on a Sabbath morning.

What gets measured gets done. So, measurements are important whether you are baking a cake (don't want the wrong amount of baking powder) or whether you are driving (measure the speed limit), and even in church. Measurements are critical to our success of doing the ministry God has called us to do.
