Community News

At our Business Meeting on Sunday, March 7, we voted and approved the mission and vision of the church. Please keep praying for the advancement of the church as we seek to follow-through on God's plans for us.

The Mission of the Adventist Community Church is: to Reach Deep in Discipleship, Reach Out in Evangelism, and Reach Up in Worship.

Our Voted Core Values are:

Our deeply held beliefs about HOW we do ministry as we pursue our Mission:

- 1. Full devotion to Christ and His cause is normal.** This is a journey that never ends for the believer. Discipleship is following Christ as outlined in our discipleship process.
- 2. Lost people matter to God, therefore they matter to us.** This means we prioritize the lost in our decisions – money, programming, and ministries. *(We will always maintain our doctrinal purity to the distinctive Adventist truths while we seek to win the lost at whatever other costs.)*
- 3. Life is best when lived within a community of believers.** We can accomplish this by our accountable acceptance of everyone, through our worship together, and through our use of community groups for socializing, discipleship, congregational care and service.
- 4. Effectiveness honors God and inspires people.** This means we will consistently listen to the Holy Spirit in our evaluation and measurement of discipleship, evangelism, and worship.
- 5. The role of leadership is to equip members for team ministry.** These teams will serve inside and outside the church. Leadership will help people determine their gift mix and their ability to serve in a ministry team.

Our Church-wide Objectives are these:

- To recruit more Community Group members and to actively train 35 new Group Leaders. This, we believe, will lead to 240 people in Community Groups and those people will go through our discipleship curriculum.
- To have 350 people involved in at least one segment of our Evangelism process (bridge events, friendship evangelism, service projects, reaping seminars, etc.) which will in turn lead us to baptize 125 people over the next three years.
- To get 300 people involved in a regular, personal devotional plan of Bible study and prayer. This will help our overall worship and attendance at our weekly worship to grow to 600 in attendance.
