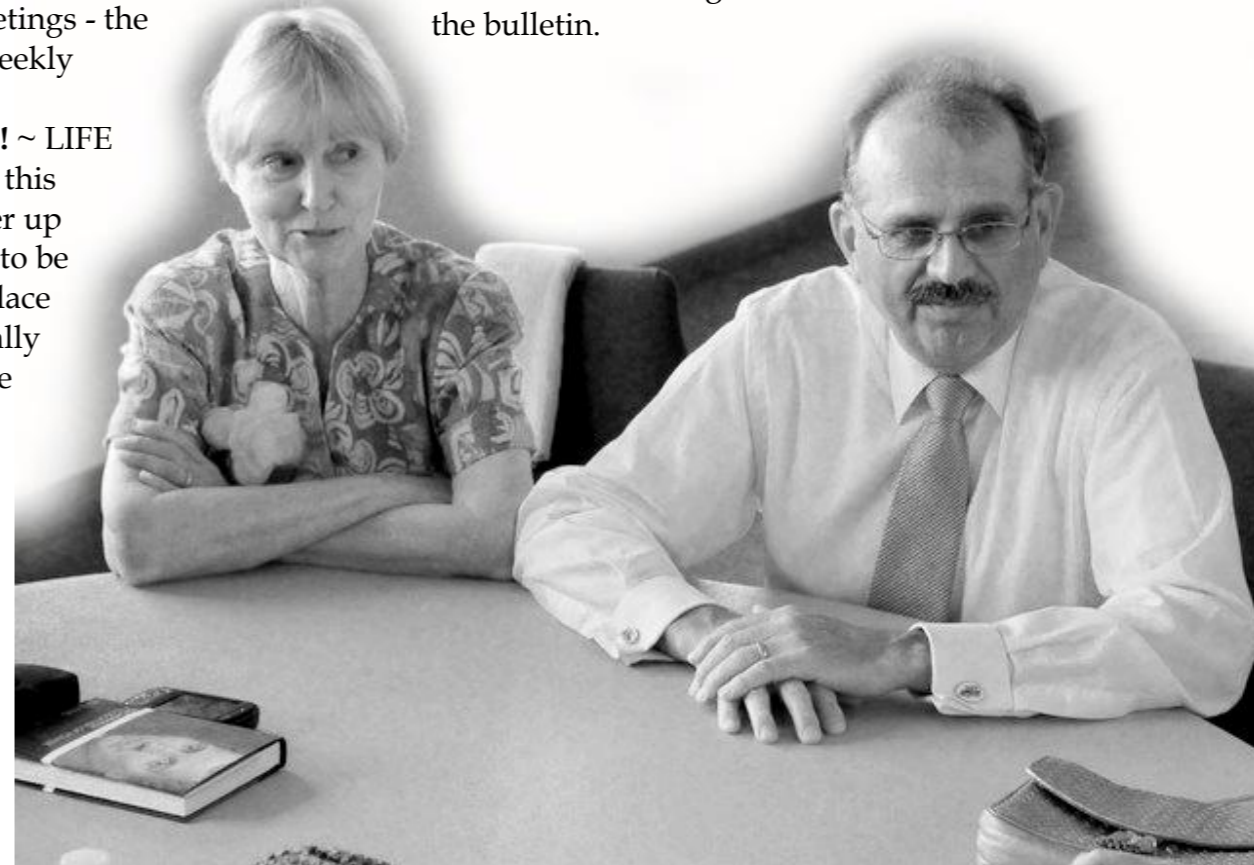
Things You Can Do!
