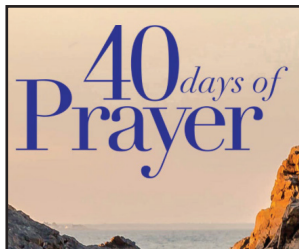


# Your Church News
