CCACS Matching Gift Challenge

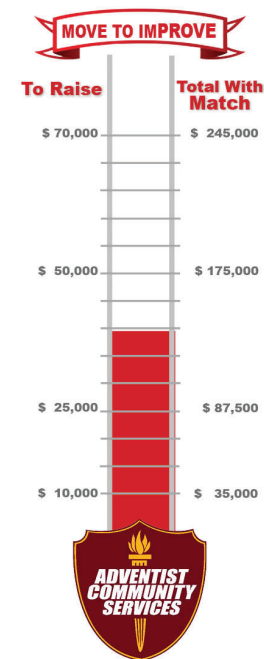
Now through June 20, 2018
