❖ We welcome you to our worship, study and fellowship times this morning. Please join us in our fellowship center after today's second service for good food and great conversation.

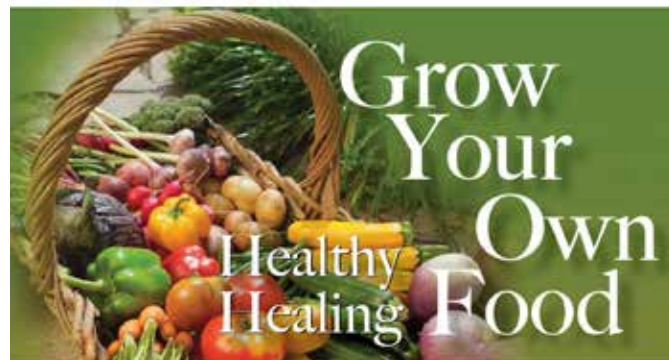

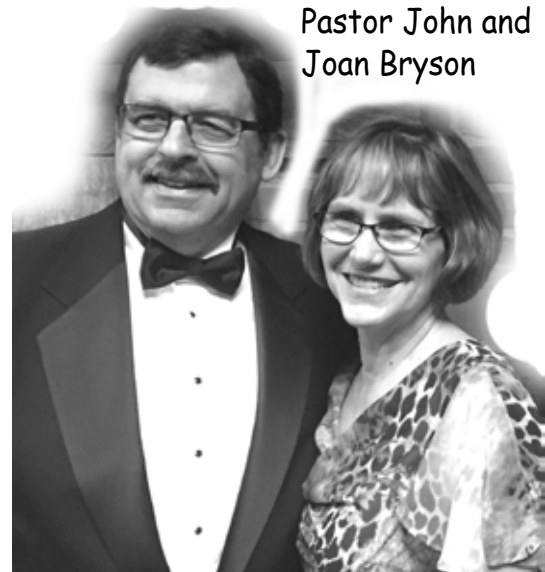
